The following criteria must be met by each applicant to apply for this scholarship:

- 1. Must be a senior at Lower Richland High School, and must have attended Lower Richland at least 2 years.
- 2. Must write an essay of 500-750 words on the topic:

 "My role and responsibility to my community after my high school graduation"
- 3. Upload a copy of your senior photo.
- 4. Have at least a 2.0 or higher GPA and planning to attend a technical college, 2 year or 4 year institution of higher education.
- 5. Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official (Principal, Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Coach, etc.) and one from someone in your community (Pastor, Mentor, Supervisor, etc.).
- 6. If named a scholarship winner you must be able to provide proof of enrollment in institution of higher education (no funds will be disbursed without this information).
- 7. All applications must be submitted by MARCH 15, 2024. (No exceptions)
- 8. Award presentations will be made at the Annual Diamond Festival Gospel Night Concert.
- 9. ONLY COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED! NO EXCEPTIONS
